After School Arts at the Arts Center Pottery Studio Spring 2012 Grades K-1

Come work with the Arts Center's Potter, Christin Bentley to unleash your creative side after school. During this six week program, students will follow a progressive curriculum to learn new handbuilding and sculpting techniques and follow the ceramic process through to finish by glazing their own art work.

Each class will begin with a small drawing exercise followed by a demonstration of the weekly project, which will allow lots of time to play in the clay.

Tuesday, February 28, 3:30-5:00 pm

Use your hands to work with clay and your imagination to make a decorated candle holder.

Tuesday, March 6, 3:30-5:00 pm

Celebrate St. Patrick's Day by creating clay shamrocks to attach to your project of choice.

Tuesday, March 13, 3:30-5:00 pm

Bring your favorite story to lend inspiration for your own bookends, decorated in the theme of your book. Learn to use the slab roller to create them.

Tuesday, March 20, 3:30-5:00 pm

Use bamboo glaze brushes and learn painting techniques to glaze bisque fired pieces.

Tuesday, March 27, 3:30-5:00 pm

Roll out your clay into a series of coils and assemble them into a bowl.

Students will pick out the color they would like the piece dip glazed.

Tuesday, April 10, 3:30-5:00 pm

Ring in spring by painting a terra cotta pot. Class will be followed by a Cookies & Punch Art Reception. Parents are invited to join us for the last 15 minutes of class so we can show off student work. Students will pick one piece to leave on display in the Arts Center's back gallery.
